



Senate Republicans – 16 Democrats – 14








Session Snapshot

Day - 72 Bills Introduced – 1782 Bills signed into law – 22

Last week for bills in committee





- FY 2021 \$13.8 billion
- Proposition 208 Dead
- Income tax likely repeal and accelerate
- Likely surplus of \$3.1 billion



Water Issues

- 266 water bills introduced
- ISSUE: Property rights and water rights
- HB 2409 CAP infrastructure
- HB 2725 Water Authority



Economic Development

- Workforce development (HB 2122, HB 2123, HB 2017)
- HB 2678 State broadband office
- SB 1093 Business property assessment ratio
