Last week for bills in committee

Arizona Budget



- FY 2021 – \$13.8 billion
- Proposition 208 – Dead
- Income tax likely repeal and accelerate
- Likely surplus of \$3.1 billion

Water Issues

- 266 water bills introduced
- ISSUE: Property rights and water rights
- HB 2409 – CAP infrastructure
- HB 2725 – Water Authority



Economic Development

- Workforce development (HB 2122, HB 2123, HB 2017)
- HB 2678 – State broadband office
- SB 1093 – Business property assessment ratio



Business Issues

- COVID Liability legislation
- HB2101/SB1631 – Electric reliability
- HB 2822 – Business personal property tax depreciation
- SB 1093 – Business property assessment ratio
- Repeal and accelerate



Transportation Issues

- SB 1239 – I-10 widening appropriation
- HB 2184 – SR 24 extension
- HB2598/SB1356 – Maricopa County regional transportation reauthorization
- HB 2728 – ADOT tier 2 studies
